REGISTRATION POLICIES

Registrations must include a NON-REFUNDABLE \$250.00 deposit per child.

Full payment for camp is due by **June 1, 2009**.

Payment plans for every other month or monthly will be issued by the Business office. JCC accepts VISA, MasterCard and Discover, EBT and EFT's.

After June 1, 2009, payment for additional weeks is due at time of registration.

Reservations for additional weeks must be made the Wednesday prior to the session of attendance.

There are no makeup days or refunds for absence due to sickness or other reasons.

A \$25 administrative fee will be assessed for each time a change is made to your camp enrollment after April 1, 2009.

Limited financial aid is available by application that must be received or postmarked by March 1, 2009.

Cancellation Policy —All deposits are non-refundable and may not be applied to other JCC outstanding fees. After May 1, 2009, no refunds will be made for absences or withdrawals.

PARTICIPATION POLICIES

JCC reserves the right to cancel any program because of insufficient enrollment. In this event we will make every effort to accommodate the child in one of our other programs.

Applications are accepted reserving the right and responsibility of Camp JCC administration to place the camper by unit and program, according to his or her own age level and readiness standards. Director should be made aware of any special needs or limitations of the individual camper.

The Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper whose behavior or influence is detrimental to the camp community.

TRANSPORTATION

Roundtrip busing to and from neighborhood stops and the JCC is available at a cost of \$40.00 per camper per week. Bus counselors and camp staff will ride the buses to help ensure your child's safety.

I understand that my child's name, address, phone number and e-mail will be provided to other campers unless otherwise requested.

All campers must have a current physical examination and health form filled out by the child's pediatrician or physician. A JCC medical form will be provided. Please make sure your doctor fills out all sections, including immunization records, general health, and allergies.

AWESOME ADD-ON EXTENDED DAY AT THE JCC

Supervised care is available for campers as early as 7:30 am and until 6:00 pm at the JCC of Allentown for an additional fee of \$25/week AM and \$37/week PM.

Camp busses will pick the kids up from the Center and take them out to the Campsite for the start of the camp day and return them to the center at the end of the day.
